Purpose: A *DRP* involves research conducted by a graduate student under the supervision of a member of the graduate faculty and also requires:

1. a clear statement of a hypothesis or proposition,
2. a review of the relevant literature,
3. an analysis and synthesis data or scholarly evidence,
4. inferences or conclusions.

The results must be stated in a report written in clear and effective English and cannot be incorporated into the student's thesis or dissertation. Any individual who has been admitted to the Graduate College is eligible to conduct a Directed Research project.
